



Northenden Community School : Governance Confirmation of Governor's Eligibility

No-one may serve as a governor who is/has:

- under 18 years of age;
- in the case of a parent governor, paid to work at the school for more than 500 hours per year or if they are an elected member of the Local Authority;
- holds another governor post at the same school at the same time;
- not attended Governing Body meetings for a period of six months or more without the consent of the Governing Body (disqualification is for a period of twelve months)
- barred from any regulated activity related to children, or is included in the list of teachers or workers considered by the Secretary of State as unsuitable to work with children or young people, or is disqualified from working with children or from registering for childminding or providing day care;
- is disqualified from being an independent school proprietor, teacher or employee by the Secretary of State;
- is the subject of a bankruptcy or debt relief order;
- is subject to a disqualification order under the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986 or to an order made under Section 429 (2) of the Insolvency Act 1986;
- has been removed from the office of charity trustee or trustee for a charity by the Charity Commission or High Court on grounds of any misconduct or mismanagement
- has been sentenced to three months or more in prison (without the option of a fine) in the five years before becoming a governor or since becoming a governor;
- has received a prison sentence of two years or more 20 years before becoming a governor;
- has at any time received a prison sentence of five years or more;
- has been fined for causing a nuisance or disturbance on school premises during the five years prior to or since appointment or election as a governor;
- refuses to an application being made to the Criminal Records Bureau for a criminal records certificate
