SUMMER REPORTS

We issued the children's end of year reports on Tuesday of this week. We apologise that the reports were sent out a day later than we had hoped to do. There was a lot of checking and printing to do before the reports were sent home and we didn't quite achieve this for all classes on Monday. Some parents have raised a question about the 'W' grades that children might have been given for subjects other than English and Mathematics. These are shown on the final page of your child's report. We apologise that the meaning of this grade was omitted from the letter. The 'W' means 'Working Towards' and effectively means that the child has not yet fully achieved all of the expectations of the year group in that subject.

Judging by the response of the audience on both nights, we think that everyone enjoyed the show. ATTENDANCE FOR 2016 - 2017

Our whole-school attendance for the year up to July was **96.7%**. We are pleased with this level of attendance but it is slightly lower than last year. 192 children were absent at some point during the year due to illness with another 422 learning days lost due to holidays taken during term time. Having said that, we were pleased to present over 140 children (58%) with certificates this week for attendance of 97% or better (the school target), 20 of whom received certificates for 100% attendance. Well done, everyone. Let try and get our whole-school attendance back to previous levels next year – that is at least 97% if we can.

As many of you will be buying new school uniform for the new academic year, we remind you that our school uniform is published on our website. Please do not plan for your child to wear shoes with flashing lights or trainers for school as these are not part of our school uniform. Thank you.

AFTER-SCHOOL CLUB

After-school Club booking forms were sent out a few weeks ago to all parents already registered with our After-School Club. CHARGES from SEPTEMBER 2017

The Governing Body have recently reviewed the school's Charging and Remissions policy and have determined that some of our charges will be increasing with effect from 1st September 2017. The charges affected are as follows:



- After-School Club : Long Session, £11.00, Short Session £5.50
- Morning Club : £2.00 per session (no sibling discount from 1st September)
- Instrumental Lessons (woodwind and brass) : £25 per term
- Nursery Fees £12 per afternoon

All other charges, including after-school sports and extra-curricular activities (£10.00 per programme), school meals (£2.25 per meal) and school milk (£7.00 per term) will remain the same. Please do not forget that dinner money, milk money and fees for all other activities should always be paid in advance. From September, we are accepting payments for milk by cash or cheque only rather than via Parent Pay. All payments for school milk should be paid by the end of the first week back, that is by Friday 8th September. No payments or requests for milk will be accepted after that date for the half-term period September – October. Payments for both morning club and after-school made via Parent Pay should be made in advance. Thank you for your co-operation.

Please do not forget, particularly Year 6 parents, to pay any debts you have remaining with the school. If you have not done this already, this can be done via Parent Pay or by cheque posted to the school. This should include any outstanding payments for residential or other visits. Thank you.

SUMMER BUILDING WORK



We are having some internal building and repair work carried out during the summer holidays. This will include some repairs, plastering and decorating of our corridors but more significantly the remodelling of our foyer and office area. This will include the creation of a new reception area and office which will mean our foyer and waiting area will be smaller but more secure for school staff and children when you all return to school in September.
