On behalf of the Governing Body, we would like to announce the results of our Parent Governor Election for which letters were sent to every family a few weeks ago. A secret ballot of parents was carried out with a closing date of Friday 26th January. 137 (43%) of 322 issued ballot papers were returned by parents.

We would also like to take this opportunity to thank and extend our commiserations to Charlotte Lennox and Russell Miller who also stood for election. Thank you to everyone who returned a ballot form and took part in this process.

2018 - 2019 TERM DATES

Please remember that the school does not authorise any holidays during term time and that parents who choose to take their children on holiday during school time could face a penalty notice (a fine) of £120 (per child per parent) which could be, and has been for some parents, very costly.



HEALTH SNACKS PLEASE

We have for many years been comitted and signed up to the Government's Healthy Schools and Change4Life schemes and have also promoted the eating of health snacks and lunches in school. We have noticed that some children are bringing in snacks and have items in their lunch boxes which are high in fat, sugar or salt (or all three). Change4Life have recently launched their 100 Calories snacks advice and we would like you to consider that advice when providing snacks for your children. More information is available on the Change 4 Life website. We ask that you do not provide chocolate as a snack, chocolate spreads or send nuts into school any form, given that we have a number of children with allergies.
