


Home Learning Weekly Plan Week Beginning: Monday 18th January 2021

DAY	MATHEMATICS TASK	ENGLISH TASK	OTHER SUBJECT TASKS
Monday	Today's Maths is all about Adding by making 10 Watch the <u>video</u> and complete the activity. Today's lesson does not have a White Rose activity sheet. Please use the <u>ten frames provided</u> to complete the activity. If you do not have counters or cubes you can use objects from around you house e.g. Lego, beads, pieces of paper etc. I have also made a <u>booklet</u> including some great resources to recap your number bonds to 10.	Spelling - Look at your spellings for this week and complete your first Write/Cover and the activity sheet. Writing - Put your spelling words into sentences. Remember to include capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. Can you make your sentences more interesting by including adjectives? You can use the worksheet attched or write your sentences into the exercise book provided in your pack. I have included a sentence building activity to support sentence structure and forming sentences correctly. You could use these cards and add in the spelling words.	Topic – Toys – Family favourites You are going to be finding about toys in the past and recording your findings. Have a look at the 'Family Favourites presentation'. Read all about what toys were like in the past, what were they made from? Do you still play with the same toys your parents/grandparents used to? Now complete the activity sheet with all your findings.
Tuesday	Today's Maths is all about Adding by making 10 Watch the video and complete the worksheet Add by making 10	The Muddy Teddy Bear Activity — Watch this video about verbs. Then complete the activity sheet. Challenge: What happens to the verb 'clean' when you add '—est' to it? Writing — Now let's start writing our stories! Use the pictures from last week to help you. Remember to include: adjectives, 'and, also try to include some verbs from the activity earlier. There is a sheet for you to write on if needed. Please complete the story over two days. Spelling - Complete your Write/Cover spelling practice.	Phonics We have covered all of our Phase 3 phonics sounds. Please continue to revise and recap these sounds. Today we are going to be looking at our Phase 5 sounds. We will begin by revisiting the /ay/ sound and then learning the /ou/ sound. Please watch the video on Seesaw and then complete the activity sheets (ou and ay). There are a few activities for each sound so please just work through these over the next week.

Wednesday	Today's Maths is all about Subtracting - not crossing 10 Watch the video and complete the worksheet Subtraction – not crossing 10	Writing - The Muddy Teddy Bear Today we are going to continue writing our story about the muddy teddy bear. Keep checking your writing for capital letters and full stops. On the sheet provided there is space for you to illustrate your writing. I am excited to read all of your stories. Spelling - Complete your Write/Cover spelling practice.	Science – Everyday Materials Today we are looking at the difference between an object and the material it is made from. Have a look at the presentation and talk about the questions. Then complete the activity sheet. To explore this even further complete the second page of the activity sheet – have a look around your house and see what materials different objects are made from.
Thursday	Today's Maths is all about Subtracting - not crossing 10 (counting back) Watch the <u>video</u> and complete the worksheet <u>Subtraction - not crossing 10 (counting back) 1</u>	Reading comprehension Complete the comprehension worksheet for week 3 provided in your packs. Spelling - Complete your Write/Cover spelling practice.	Watch the story – The Way Back Home Design a rocket Today you are going to become a designer! Firstly, have a look around your house and see what you could make a rocket out of. You could use Lego, boxes, bottles etc. Then think about how you could use these materials to make your very own rocket but don't make it just yet! You are going to plan and design your rocket. Use the sheet provided or a piece of paper to draw and label your rocket design. Include what materials you are going to use. Let's get creative! Make a rocket Today you are going to make your rocket. Use your design from yesterday and let's get building! I can't wait to see your amazing creations on Seesaw. 3, 2, 1 Blast off!
Friday	Today's Maths is all about Subtracting - not crossing 10 (counting back) Watch the video and complete the worksheet Subtraction – not crossing 10 (counting back) 2	Spelling test Complete your spelling test for the week, ask an adult to test you on your spellings. Handwriting Find the caterpillar letter handwriting booklet from your packs. There will be a short video posted on Seesaw modelling how to form the letters correctly.
