


Home Learning Weekly Plan Week Beginning: Monday 1st March 2021

DAY	MATHEMATICS TASK	ENGLISH TASK	OTHER SUBJECT TASKS
Monday	Today's Maths is all about Comparing lengths Watch the <u>video</u> and complete the activities Can you compare the lengths of anything else around your house? Take photos of your findings and upload them to Seesaw.	Spelling - Look at your spellings for this week and complete your first Write/Cover and the activity sheet. Writing - Put your spelling words into sentences. Remember to include capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and adjectives. Try to focus on your letter formation, can you include any of our cursive caterpillar letters in your writing? Challenge - Your challenge is to use 'because' in at least one of your sentences. We can use 'because' to extend our sentences and help us explain why.	Science – Animals including humans Today we are starting our new Science topic and we will be looking at the different parts of our body. Draw a picture of a person and label it with the labels provided in your pack or write the words on yourself. Have a look at the labels to ensure you have included everything in your drawing.
Tuesday	Today's Maths is all about Comparing heights Watch the <u>video</u> and complete the activities Can you compare the heights of anything else around your house? Take photos of your findings and upload them to Seesaw.	The Colour Monster — Today we are continuing to look at 'The Colour Monster'. In your pack you have two speech bubbles, you are going to use these to write about times you have felt the emotion on your mood board e.g. I feel calm and relaxed when I am reading a fantastic book. There is then space at the top for you to illustrate your writing. Remember to include capital letters, full stops and adjectives to describe. Spelling - Complete your Write/Cover spelling practice.	Religious Education — What is a place of worship? Synagogue Today we are going to be looking at a Jewish place of worship called a synagogue. Your activity is to draw and label a synagogue. Have a look through the presentation and maybe online at synagogues to see what they look like. The presentation includes different facts and features of a synagogue which you could also include in your drawing and labelling.

Wednesday	Today's Maths is all about Comparing lengths and heights Watch the video and complete the worksheet Compare lengths and heights	Silly Billy — Today we are looking at another story linked to emotions and, in particular, worry. You can listen to the story here and I will also read it in our Zoom session. Then have a think about different things that might worry you, it can be anything, from something small to something big. You are then going to make a story board of four different things that might worry you. Draw a picture and write a sentence. Can you include 'because' in your sentence to explain why you feel this way? Spelling - Complete your Write/Cover spelling practice.	Topic – Hot and cold places For our new topic we will be looking at hot and cold places and the continents of the world. Today you are going to create a poster about hot and cold places. You could focus on specific countries / continents that are hot and cold or maybe you could think of more general ideas about these places e.g. polar bears, penguins, snow in cold climates and camels, sand, sun in hot climates etc. I look forward to seeing all your different ideas!
Thursday	Today's Maths is all about Measuring lengths (non-standard units) Watch the video and complete the activities Take photos of your findings and upload them to Seesaw.	Reading comprehension Complete the comprehension worksheet for week 8 provided in your packs. Spelling test Complete your spelling test for the week, ask an adult to test you on your spellings.	Phonics Today we will be learning the sound /au/ - 'Paul the astronaut'. Please watch the videos on Seesaw and then complete the activity sheets. There are a few activities to work through so please complete these over the next week. Read this book from Oxford Owl, it contains the /au/ sound. (Don't forget you will need to log in to Oxford Owl first).
Friday	Today's Maths is all about Measuring length (1) Watch the video and complete the worksheet Measure length	Spelling test Complete your spelling test for the week, ask an adult to test you on your spellings. Handwriting Find the caterpillar letter handwriting booklet from your packs and complete the next letter. I will attach some links on Seesaw to support you.	ICT – Purple Mash 2Go – Today you are going to give simple instructions, learn directions and explore simple logo. Complete challenges 1 and 2, you can find these by clicking on 'challenges' in the bottom left corner. Then you can make your own design, try to include 4 objects to reach. You could ask someone in your family to see if they can get to all the different points. I will show you exactly how to access this in our Zoom session. Have fun!
