DAY	MATHEMATICS	ENGLISH TASKS FOR THIS WEEK	OTHER SUBJECT TASKS
Monday	Visit the White Rose website and watch today's lesson video. You can also visit the BBC BiteSize website for lessons and activities on the same topic. Today's Lesson : Ordering Numbers	Spelling - Look at your spellings for this week and complete your first Write/Cover activity. Reading Comprehension – 'How do you feel?' read the sentences and think about how you would feel about each one.	Science – Being safe in the sun Watch the video clip about staying safe in the sun and then have a look at the ' Sun Safety ' code. You are going to be creating a poster about being safe in the sun, you can use the template provided or make your own.
Tuesday	Visit the White Rose website and watch today's lesson video. You can also visit the BBC BiteSize website for lessons and activities on the same topic. Today's Lesson : Recognising Coins	Spelling - Complete your Write/Cover activity. Giraffes Can't Dance – Watch the story . Draw a picture and write about what you love to do. Try to add more detail to your sentences including adjectives and extend your sentences using 'because'. There is an activity sheet provided .	Topic – History of Flight I hope you had fun making your paper planes. Today we are going to look at the history of flight – look at the presentation and use the activity sheet to create a timeline. Can you include dates on your timeline?

Today's Lesson : Recognising Notes	Spelling - Complete your Write/Cover activity. Giraffes Can't Dance – What can't you do YET? Gerald does not give up and neither should you! Draw a picture and write about something that you would like to learn how to do, why you want to learn and how you will learn. There is an activity sheet provided .	Art – Drawing Inspired by our book this week 'Giraffes Can't Dance' you are going to draw a giraffe . There is a step-by-step guide for you to follow and then you can decorate your giraffe how you like. You could use paints, pencil crayons or even collage.
