

These animals are mammals.


Can you think of more animals that are mammals?

Can you think of more animals that are fish?






These animals are reptiles.

Can you think of more animals that are reptiles?






These animals are birds.

Can you think of more animals that are birds?






These animals are amphibians.

Can you think of more animals that are amphibians?










