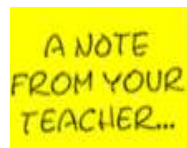




Home Learning Weekly Plan

Monday	<p>Complete today's Timestable Rockstars sheet.</p> <p>Today's Maths is all about multiplying 2 digits by 1 digit – exchange.</p> <p>Watch the video and complete the worksheet</p>	<p><u>Spelling Week 8</u> Copy out your practice words and complete the activities.</p> <p><u>Handwriting</u> Complete 2 activities from the handwriting booklet in your pack.</p> <p><u>Reading</u> Have a look at the 3 pictures from the book. The illustrator has been very clever and hidden pictures of other things in the trees. What can you spot? Are they in anyway related to each other?</p>	<p><u>History</u> <u>Athens V Sparta</u> Athens and Sparta were both cities in Greece, but they were very different. <u>Activity 1</u> – Read through the information. <u>Activity 2</u> – Complete the worksheet to compare the cities and then explain which one you would rather have lived in. <u>Activity 3</u> – Look at the picture of the soldier on the BBC website. Draw and label your own Greek soldier.</p>

It sounds like a lovely place to visit doesn't it. <u>Activity 2</u> - Imagine that you are on holiday in Greece. I would like you to send me a postcard telling me all about it. You should include information about the weather, the landscape, what you have seen and what you have been doing. You might have been on a day trip to somewhere exciting, eaten some delicious Greek food or watched some traditional Greek dancing. I want to know all about it.</p>

Wednesday	<p>Complete today's Timestable Rockstars sheet.</p> <p>Today's Maths is all about dividing 2 digits by 1 digit (1)</p> <p>Watch the video and complete the worksheets</p>	<p><u>Spelling Week 8</u> Copy out your words.</p> <p><u>The Tunnel by Anthony Browne</u> In the story, Rose lies awake at night listening to the noises. What could these noises be? Write some descriptive phrases, for example, the cold wind rustling the leaves on the old oak tree or dad snoring like a rhinoceros.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> <u>Light</u> You will need a mirror for today's lesson. We use mirrors every day, but do you know how one works? This week we are going to do some tests to find out how a mirror works. <u>Activity 1</u> – Watch the short video and complete the quiz. <u>Activity 2</u> – Use the worksheet to complete each test to see what you find out about mirrors and how they work.</p>
Thursday	<p>Complete today's Timestable Rockstars sheet.</p> <p>Today's Maths is all about dividing 2 digits by 100 (2)</p> <p>Watch the video and complete the worksheets</p>	<p><u>Spelling Week 8</u> Copy out your words.</p> <p><u>The Tunnel by Anthony Browne</u> Rose struggled to decide whether to go in the tunnel or not. Write a list of reasons why she should or should not go in. What would you have done in that situation? Why?</p>	<p><u>Music</u> <u>Understanding Pulse and Rhythm</u> For today's music lesson, we will be using the video on the Oak Academy website. You will need headphones (so you don't disturb anyone else) a pencil, paper and your hands. You will be learning how to find the pulse, clap the rhythm and use your body as percussion. Have fun!</p>
Friday	<p>Complete today's Timestable Rockstars sheet.</p> <p>Today's Maths is all about dividing 100</p> <p>Watch the video and complete the worksheet</p>	<p><u>Spelling Week 8</u> Ask someone to test you on this week's spelling words. <u>Comprehension – Whale of a Tale (in pack)</u> Read the text and answer the questions. There are 3 sections. Comprehension – the answers to the questions are in the story. All about words – find out more about the words used. Grammar – Look at the types of words and sentences used.</p>	<p><u>ICT</u> <u>Purple Mash – Logo</u> Look in the To Do section of Purple Mash to find the activity The Minotaur's Maze. Your task is to direct the child through the maze to safety to protect the future. You will use the commands fd, rt 90 and lt 90. Watch the short introduction video, which will explain what to do.</p>
