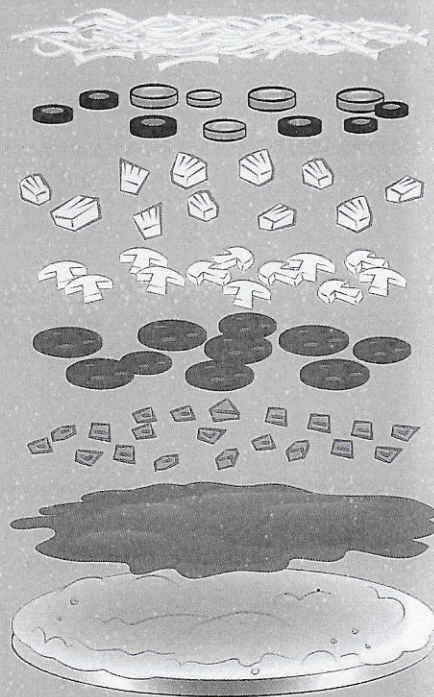


# Talk to a pizza
