To answer the questions correctly you must be able to find the 'evidence' in the text. Please complete the <a href="#">comprehension activity</a> focussing on retrieval.	<b>History</b> – Take a look at this BBC Bitesize page.  <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zvhtwnb">https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zvhtwnb</a>  This site gives lots of information about who the Viking were and will complement the things you have already learned. When you have explored the site, complete Task 1 by creating a Viking quiz. It should feature 10 questions and I have attached a template.

This could be the main ideas of one paragraph, or we might need to talk about the main ideas of the whole text. Please complete the <a href="#">comprehension activity</a> focussing on summarising.	Next, read pages 22-23 of <a href="#">Viking Invaders and Settlers</a> on Curriculum Visions. Can you make a list to compare your house to a Viking house?

You can also visit the <a href="#">BBC BiteSize</a> website for lessons and activities on the same topic. <b>Today's Lesson</b> <a href="#">Translation</a>	<b>Inference</b> – When answering inference questions we are thinking about things we can find out from the text, but that might not be directly explained. For example, if a story describes a character getting wrapped up in warm clothing, we know that the setting might be a cold environment. Please complete the <a href="#">inference activity</a> .	<b>PSHE</b> – This month is Pride Month. What can do you already know, and what can you find out about Pride? Why is it important? What does it stand for? What can we learn from Pride Month? Make a poster using the <a href="#">template</a> to show what you have found.
Friday	Visit the <a href="#">White Rose website</a> and select this week .  <b>Today's Lesson</b> <b>Challenge of the week</b>	<b>Predict</b> – Prediction questions ask us to think about what might happen in the text. We need to use what we already know about the characters, setting and story to make reasonable predictions that fit with what we have already read. Please complete the <a href="#">prediction activity</a> .	<b>Art</b> – This week I would like you to create an abstract art picture. Abstract art is about expressing your thoughts and feeling with colours and shapes, but without drawing anything specific. Take <a href="#">a look at the examples</a> and try it for yourself!
