DAY	MATHEMATICS	ENGLISH TASKS FOR THIS WEEK	OTHER SUBJECT TASKS
Monday	Can you add the decimal numbers together? You can use the column method which we know so well to help you. Remember that the decimal points should all stay in line. Take a look at the examples and then try the challenges! Worksheet 1	WorkCan you find the imperative verbs in this set of instructions? Can you use what you have learned to write your own set of instructions using imperative verbs? Worksheet 1	Art This week I would like you to do think about the botanical drawings we looked at previously, and use this style to draw some plant life from around your home or garden. This could be a house plant, something from the garden or even a dandelion growing up through a crack in the pavement. Remember that botanical drawings need: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Lots of detail - Accurate colours - shading
Tuesday	Today lets look at subtracting decimal numbers . You will need to use the column method again and make sure you look carefully at the examples, and think about how they relate to what you already know about subtraction before you try the challenges.	You have a set of instructions, but they are not in the correct order! Can you re-order them so that they can be followed properly? Worksheet 2	
Wednesday	What do you need to add to the numbers to turn them into the target number? Take a look at the examples and then have a go for yourself. Worksheet 3	To help someone follow a set of instructions, we can add adverbs or adverbials? These words tell us how, when and where something happens. Can you improve the instructions by adding adverbs like I have? Worksheet 3	History Please read page 4 and 5 of the Viking Raiders and Settlers book on Curriculum Visions. When you have read the pages please complete the comprehension questions.
Thursday	Today we will be ordering decimal numbers. Please complete the word problems in the linked worksheet. Problem Solving Worksheet	Imagine there is a new child joining the class.
