What kind of woman was this?

How do you know that this was an ongoing problem?

Give examples of what she used to say.

Who do you think she gossiped about?

Why did she do it, in your opinion?

Is gossip a kind of bullying? Why/why not?

Who is a Rabbi and why is she likely to take notice of him?

Why do you think that he simply didn't tell her to stop?

What did he make her do?

What did her actions demonstrate?

On a scale of 1 to 10 how big a gossip are you? (Be honest – I'm not going to judge)

Has this ever backfired on you? How?

Why is it so important to say good things about somebody in a positive way?

Think of a suitable moral for this fable.

Write a similar short fable of your own, entitled 'Gossip'.
