Play I Spy - how many things can you find around the house that begin with o?</p>	<p>UW/EAD Experimenting with environmental sounds. Get your grown up to do the same activity and then talk about who has the most amount of objects, who has the least amount.</p>	<p>Writing Learn how to write o using the Read, Write Ink sheet in your home learning pack (all around the orange), encourage your child to start forming the letter in the same place as for the letter a, going in an anti-clockwise direction.</p>	<p>UW/EAD If you have an instrument, can you make quiet sounds and loud sounds with it? Can you play it slowly/fast? Talk about the different sounds.</p>
