DAY	MATHEMATICS	ENGLISH TASKS FOR THIS WEEK	OTHER SUBJECT TASKS
Monday	Floating and sinking activity. Put some of your toys in a tub of water and see which ones float and which ones sink. What makes the toys float or sink do you think?	Phonics Teach the b sound. Watch Mrs Johnston's phonics video on Seesaw. Listen to the Jolly Phonics rhyme which goes with the b sound.	PD Gross motor skills – get ready for returning to school: please practise getting dressed and undressed, fastening and undoing buttons and zips, being able to put on, take off your shoes and fasten the Velcro fastenings.
Tuesday	Sizes. Have a look for 3 things the same – toys, sticks, stones, leaves, coins, plates, cups – can you put them in order of size – which is the biggest, smallest and middle sized?	Write Dance (music and movement to support handwriting) watch the video and join in with the actions Write Dance The Volcano	EAD make a stone sculpture or tower (example attached)
Wednesday	Play a game of catch with a ball, when you drop the ball, you lose a point. You could record points using a tally chart and count up who has the most points at the end.	Writing Using Read, Write, Inc. resources – teach how to write ' b ' - Show picture card. Say "Down the laces to the heel and around the toe". Ask the children to use their finger in the air, on the table, on grownups back etc. to practice writing ' b '.	EAD/UW Build a Secret Sensory Den. Secretly add objects with a variety of textures, weights and shapes for your child to discover...who left them there? Vary it and make it into a Story Den sharing a book by torchlight. Can you introduce new colours, lights, soft music, or a breeze?
Thursday	Have a time challenge. Give your child an action to do e.g. hop, skip, jump, clap or star jump. How many can they do in one minute? Keep a record of the scores. Ask everyone in the house to have a go.	Speaking and Listening Listen to Mrs Johnston read one of Nursery's favourite stories for World Book Day ' <i>Oi Dog</i> ' (on Seesaw)	PD Practicing Pencil Grip (assigned activity on Seesaw)
Friday	Counting under the sea creatures. Follow the link to play a counting game. There is a simpler version with amounts to 5 and a more challenging version with amounts to 10 https://www.topmarks.co.uk/lerning-to-count/underwater-counting	Shared Reading Log in to Oxford Owl and share the ebook with your child A Home for Ted	UW Parts of the Human Body Ask your child which parts of the body they use to run? To do a handstand? What do you stand on? etc.
