DAY	MATHEMATICS	ENGLISH TASKS FOR THIS WEEK	OTHER SUBJECT TASKS
Monday	<p><b>Shape repeating patterns</b> – start at level 1 and see if you can progress to level 3</p> <p><a href="https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ordering-and-sequencing/shape-patterns">https://www.topmarks.co.uk/ordering-and-sequencing/shape-patterns</a></p>	<p>Teach the <b>I</b> sound. Watch Mrs Johnston’s phonics video on Seesaw.</p>	<p><b>UW/EAD</b> Flags - Look <a href="#">at flags from around the world</a>. Discuss which are your child’s favourites and why.</p>
Tuesday	<p>Ask your child to design and make their own flag using 2D shapes.</p>	<p>Using Read, Write, Inc resources – teach how to write ‘I’ - Show picture card. Say “Down the Long Leg”. Ask the children to use their finger in the air, on the table, on grownups back etc. to practice writing ‘I’.</p>	<p><b>Understanding the World</b> Find some different foods/fruits from around the world and taste each one. These might include: pizza (Italy), curry (India) and taco (Mexican) or the fruits from the story <a href="#">‘Handa’s Surprise’</a>. (You Tube video). Your child can create a chart putting a tick next to each food they like and a cross next to the foods they dislike over the course of the week.</p>
Wednesday	<p><b>Number Paint Projects</b> Purple Mash Mini Mash. Choose your favourite number and use the paints to decorate it.</p>	<p>Listen to Mrs Johnston reading the story <i>‘Zog and the Flying Doctors’</i> by Julia Donaldson.</p>	<p><b>Understanding the World</b> Look at the presentation of <a href="#">World Foods</a> and complete the worksheet matching foods from around the world.</p>
Thursday	<p><b>Move Bees in to the Hive</b> counting game up to 20 assigned on Seesaw.</p>	<p><b>Literacy</b> Read <a href="#">‘Rag the Rat’ on Oxford Owl</a>. (Don’t forget to LOG IN first using Username NCS-1 and password NCSP1)</p>	<p><b>Understanding the World</b> Look at the presentation of <a href="#">World Foods</a> and complete the worksheet matching foods from around the world.</p>
