DAY	MATHEMATICS	ENGLISH TASKS FOR THIS WEEK	OTHER SUBJECT TASKS
Monday	Money Seesaw assigned activity – Set up a shop	Teach the j sound. Watch the Jolly Phonics video . 10 minutes.	Let's imagine – use some recycling items to make a model, it could be anything from a space rocket to a jewellery box. Try to talk through the ideas first, think about what you will need, and, when it is finished, think about whether you could add or change anything to make it even better. Please post a picture of your model on Seesaw.
Tuesday	Money Twinkl worksheet - How much money is in my jar?	Using Read, Write, Inc resources – teach how to write 'j' - Show picture card. Say “ Down his body, curl, dot for his head ”. Ask the children to use their finger in the air, on the table, on grownups back etc. to practice writing 'j'.	
Wednesday	Money Topmarks money game – sort one coin	Watch Alphablocks episode on j	Coin Roll – using a variety of round coins, challenge your child to roll the coins on their end. How far can they roll them? Which coins roll the farthest? Bigger or smaller coins? If you child is struggling to get the coin to roll you can make this easier by using a range of lids instead. You could extend this game further by giving your child a target to aim for, such as a line of tape on the floor.
Thursday	Money Set up a shop using things from around the house. Make signs, shopping lists and price tags. Use bags/baskets and pennies to play with in the shop. Take it in turns to be the shopkeeper and the customer.	Listen to the story of 'Maisy's Pool' (You Tube) Can you answer the following questions: Who is in the story? Where did it take place? What was your favourite part?	
Friday		Read together the Curriculum Visions 'Let's Visit the Seaside' (don't forget you will need the school username and password) What can you do at the seaside? What do you like doing at the seaside?	Keep fit to Andy's Wild Workout
