Hello Nursery, thank you for trying out the different activities that I have planned for you. It is always lovely to see your efforts and creativity when you post the pictures of your learning on Seesaw. I hope that you will enjoy what I have planned for the week ahead, just remember you can choose what day you would like to do each activity on, this plan just acts as a guide. **Don't forget everyday sing songs together, talk about something new, share a book together. Don't forget to laugh every day!**

| DAY | MATHEMATICS | ENGLISH TASKS FOR THIS WEEK | OTHER SUBJECT TASKS |

| Monday | Watch the 2D Shapes song (YouTube) | Using Read, Write, Inc resources - teach 'e' - Show picture card. Say "e e e egg". Practice writing 'e'. Run your finger along the picture of 'e' and say "Lift the top and scoop out the egg." Ask the children to use their finger in the air, on the table, on grownups back etc. to practice writing 'e'. | EAD/CLL using a pot and a spoon or a tub and a stick, whatever you have got, tap out the syllables in your child's name e.g. O -li-vi-a (4 taps) and get your child to copy. Tap out other names or favourite words e.g. "ice-cream", "sun-flow-er", "cat-er-pill-ar". |
| Tuesday | Practise your cutting skills by cutting out the 2D shapes . Which ones do you know? Can you ask your grown up the names of the others? | Listen to the Jolly Phonics rhyme (1min19 – 1min35) which goes with the 'e' sound on Youtube and join in with the action Listen to Mrs Johnston read the story 'Mog the Forgetful Cat' (on Seesaw) | EAD/UW 'Little Squirters' give your child a Calpol syringe or a squirty bath toy and see how many different things it can be used for – watering plants, mini water fight, drawing on slabs. |
| Wednesday | Following on from the Shape Hunt activity last week, make a Shape Book – have a look for things around your house/garden that are different shapes. Can you draw them into a shape book ...fold paper to make a zigzag book. | Play I Spy - how many things can you find that begin with e in your house? Watch Mrs Johnston's phonics video (on Seesaw). | Physical Development Take a look at the video from Cosmic Kids Yoga. If you like the idea of this activity after watching the short video, have a look at their other videos on YouTube. |
| Thursday | Number Sense (assigned activity on Seesaw) | Recreate a front cover from a storybook or a page from a storybook page. See photos on Seesaw for examples. Please post your photos on Seesaw. | UW/CLL Guess the Animal Game Ask a grown up to describe an animal, can you guess what it is? Listen carefully to the clues. Here is an example – this animal has 4 legs, can be brown, black or white, gives us milk. Do you know what animal it is? |
| Friday | Counting Songs – what counting songs can you sing together? Use the link below to join in with the songs.
