DAY	MATHEMATICS	ENGLISH TASKS FOR THIS WEEK	OTHER SUBJECT TASKS
Monday	Outdoor counting. Find nature objects and line them up in a row, count them and then write the numeral to match with chalk.	Teach the r sound. Watch Mrs Johnston's phonics video on Seesaw. Listen to the Jolly Phonics rhyme which goes with the r sound on Youtube and join in with the action. R is from 4 minutes 48 seconds.	PD Dough Disco Make salt dough (recipe attached). Join in with Play Dough Disco (YouTube) This is the activity we use in class so the children are familiar with it
Tuesday	Play a family board game – talk about taking turns and playing fairly. Dice games will support your child's number recognition.	Using Read, Write, Inc resources – teach how to write 'r' - Show picture card. Say "Down the robots back and curl over his arm". Ask the children to use their finger in the air, on the table, on grownups back etc. to practice writing 'r'.	UW/EAD Create shadow pictures with your toys (see picture attached for ideas). Can you draw around the shadows of your toys?
Wednesday	Can you count how many bears you can see on your walk around the local area? Look at windows in houses, in driveways and gardens. Make a tally chart of how many bears you see.	Listen to Mrs Johnston reading the story 'This is the Bear' by Michael Rosen. (Seesaw)	UW Look at a selection of family photos and discuss changes over time. Show your child a photo of them as a baby, a 1 year old, a 2 year old, what could they do at that age? What can they do now that they couldn't do then?
Thursday	Make a birthday card for the next family member's birthday. How old are they going to be? Can you write the numerals to show the correct age? Write a message inside the card for your family member and sign it with your name.		EAD/UW Go on an egg box treasure hunt in the garden, park or woods. Fill the egg box with different nature objects.
Friday	Log on to Education City >subjects>mathematics>EYFS>F1>activities>Candies – more or less	Log on to Phonics Play Buried Treasure Game – Phase 2 r sound. Decide which words are real and which are not. Have a go at sounding out the words e.g. r-a-d rad (fake word).	UW Find your house on google maps. Explore using goggle maps to look at your house from above and on the street view. Use the arrows to move up and down the road and around your area. Can you find key places e.g. their school, the park, the river, the shop?
