DAY	MATHEMATICS	ENGLISH TASKS FOR THIS WEEK	OTHER SUBJECT TASKS
Monday	Floating and sinking activity. Put some of your toys in a tub of water and see which ones float and which ones sink. What makes the toys float or sink do you think?	Teach the h sound. Watch Mrs Johnston's phonics video on Seesaw. Listen to the Jolly Phonics rhyme which goes with the h sound on Youtube and join in with the action. H is from 2 minutes 8 seconds.	EAD make a stone sculpture or tower (example attached)
Tuesday	Sizes. Have a look for 3 things the same – toys, sticks, stones, leaves, coins, plates, cups – can you put them in order of size – which is the biggest, smallest and middle sized?	Using Read, Write, Inc resources – teach how to write 'h' - Show picture card. Say "Down the head, to his hooves and over his back". Ask the children to use their finger in the air, on the table, on grownups back etc. to practice writing 'h'.	EAD/UW Build a Secret Sensory Den. Secretly add objects with a variety of textures, weights and shapes for your child to discover...who left them there? Vary it and make it into a Story Den sharing a book by torchlight. Can you introduce new colours, lights, soft music, or a breeze?
Wednesday	Play a game of catch with a ball, when you drop the ball, you lose a point. You could record points using a tally chart and count up who has the most points at the end.	In SEESAW, listen to Mrs Johnston reading the story 'A Quiet Night In' by Jill Murphy. Thursday	Have a time challenge. Give your child an action to do e.g. hop, skip, jump, clap or star jump. How many can they do in one minute? Keep a record of the scores. Ask everyone in the house to have a go.	Practise writing your name - use water, paints, pencils or chalks. Make the letters from outdoor objects – sticks, grass, leaves.	EAD No brush painting Can you paint with different objects? Try using potato mashers, combs, toothbrushes, bubble wrap – anything washable. Explore the different effects.
Friday	Counting under the sea creatures. Follow the link to play a counting game . There is a simpler version with amounts to 5 and a more challenging version with amounts to 10 Top Marks : Underwater Counting	Read the e book from Oxford Owl – Max's Rocket – try to sound out the letters and blend them together to read the cvc words. Don't forget that you might need to log in first.	PD Mini Sports Day Make a sports day in your garden – jumping races, egg and spoon races, hopping races – lots of fun!
