Monday	<p>Maths Lesson 1 (White Rose Maths). Today's challenge is to go for a hunt around your house to see if you can find different sized teddies. Can you put them in order of size? Can you count and label how many teddies you find?</p>	<p>Read p1-12 Changing Winter Curriculum Visions. The book asks you to think about how we know it is winter. Can you draw and label 5 signs of winter.</p>	<p>Phonics Spring Term Lesson 1 Let's write/draw a story using your 'Tales Toolkit' (home learning pack). Read the 'Baby Bird' story on Seesaw to help give you some ideas. You can write a story about 'The deep, dark woods' or choose something different. You're the writer, so you get to choose the ideas.</p>
Tuesday	<p>Maths Lesson 2 (White Rose Maths). Today's challenge is to make different groups of objects. Which groups have more and which group has less? Can you count and label how many are in each group?</p>	<p>Read p13-25 Changing Winter Curriculum Visions. Complete 'The Four Seasons' sequencing activity on Seesaw. I hope you enjoy the song.</p>	<p>Phonics Spring Term Lesson 2 Art Activity 1-Create a nature collage using natural objects you can find (See home learning pack)</p>
Wednesday	<p>Maths Lesson 3 (White Rose Maths). Today's challenge is to build a tower of three objects. Can you build a tower which is smaller and a tower which is taller than your tower?</p>	<p>Read p25-40 Changing Winter Curriculum Visions. The book asks us to think about what we like best about Winter. Write a sentence(s) and draw a picture (or photograph) to show what you like best about Winter.</p>	<p>Phonics Spring Term Lesson 3 Dance-I Like to Move It Can you follow the instructions and learn the dance. If you have dances you like to do at home post them to Seesaw and we can dance along with you in school too.</p>
Thursday	<p>Maths Lesson 4 (White Rose Maths). Today's challenge is to go for a hunt around your house and make a collection of 10 pieces of string, shoe laces, ribbon. Can you order your pieces in length? Which is the longest?</p>	<p>Read p40-55 Changing Winter Curriculum Visions. Complete 'My Scale Snowman' on Seesaw. When you finish the activity he sings a little song. I hope you enjoy it.</p>	<p>Phonics Spring Term Lesson 4 Role Play-Can you create a shop at home? Write some price tickets and ask someone to be your customer. Can you add up the amount and count the change? You might like to have a toy shop or maybe even a sandwich shop. You choose!</p>
Friday	<p>Maths Lesson 5 (White Rose Maths). Today's challenge is to find different boxes around your house. Which boxes fit inside which box? Which is the biggest? Can you find 10 different boxes or containers to use?</p>	<p>Read p55-69 Changing Winter Curriculum Visions. The book talks about animals finding it hard looking for food in the winter. Some people feed the birds and some squirrels store nuts for the winter. If you go for a walk, can you see any animals looking for food?</p>	<p>Phonics Spring Term Lesson 5 Well Done Assembly-In your home learning pack there are certificates for you to use. Write a certificate for someone you would like to say a special thank you to this week. You could be the teacher and have your own assembly at home.</p>
