DAY	MATHEMATICS	ENGLISH TASKS FOR THIS WEEK	OTHER SUBJECT TASKS
Monday	Visit the White Rose website for this week's activities. This week's activities are all based on the book ' The Princess and the Wizard ' by Julia Donaldson . If you would like to listen to the story, click here for a YouTube video .	Read p1-23 ' What is that Flower Called? ' on Curriculum Visions. Which of the flowers in the book do you already recognise and which are new to you?	Topic-Go for a flower walk and keep a tally of the different flowers you see. Which flowers did you see the most? Were there any flowers you did not see at all? Could you remember their names?
Tuesday	Visit the White Rose website for this week.	Read p23-45 ' What is that Flower Called? ' on Curriculum Visions. Which of the flowers in the book do you already recognise and which are new to you?	Art-There were lots of unusual flowers in today's read. Can you draw or paint your favourite? Pay close attention to detail seeing if you can capture the shape and texture of your flower.
Wednesday	Visit the White Rose website for this week.	Read p1-23 ' Growing Bulbs ' on Curriculum Visions. Can you explain how bulbs and seeds grow into plants using the pictures in the book to help you?	Topic-Can you follow the instructions in the book to complete the onion experiment? You will see the roots grow each day. If you don't have an onion you can use an old potato and see the shoots grow.
Thursday	Visit the White Rose website for this week.	Read p1-23 ' Growing Bulbs ' on Curriculum Visions. Ask your family or friends what they grow in their garden? Maybe send them a picture of your favourite flower.	Role Play-At school we love creating role play with your friends but you can do this at home too. Can you use your toy figures, dolls, animals and pretend they are your friends. What would you play together or say to each other?
Friday	Visit the White Rose website for this week.	Story Writing : Here is your story opener... "The children were amazed to find a secret garden where no-one had played for years" . If you need help with your writing ask an adult to be your scribe then you can read it back.	PSE - Write your happy list from this week. One thing that made you smile, one thing that made you go 'Wow!' and one thing that was really kind. I loved reading these on Seesaw.
